

ESC Principles and Priorities

1. Skipper of the ESC overall winner is entitled to become the Commodore and has the honour to organize the next ESC event

The privilege to be ESC Commodore is limited to one year only. In case the ESC commodore becomes the winner of the ESC which he and his crew organizes the honour to become commodore will automatically be passed to the next ranked skipper on the "Waiting List for future Commodores". Ranking as per boat number.
2. Skipper of the ESC overall winner is entitled to pass the honour to become Commodore to the first ranked skipper on the "Waiting List for future Commodores". Ranking as per boat number .
3. All ESC skippers are invited to call for listing on the "Waiting List for future Commodores".
4. This waiting list will be used in case the actual ESC overall winner is not able to organize the next ESC and passes the honour to become ESC Commodore to another skipper on such "Waiting List".
5. The sequence for selecting the yacht for upcoming next years ESC event will be done in the reverse order of the race results of the previous last ESC event
6. Priority will be spent on new / unknown ESC locations rather than on equal One-Size design yachts.
7. At equal ranking in previous ESC the one who has the lowest discard on points becomes first.
